

Last year we were set for great big development agenda before the global COVID-19 pandemic hit. We had plans to scale up all our programs in order to achieve more community impact and transform more lives!

This meant that we were going to expand the capacity of our youth empowerment program; sponsoring more youth for media skills training, conduct more street feeding events than any other year before, save & rehabilitate more street kids in our street kids' welfare program, and fundraise for a needy patient every week throughout the year.





While all these plans seemed very achievable and solid before the pandemic, we barely achieved our targets. The government's COVID-19 guidelines out-rightly crippled our street feeding events as all gatherings were banned.

We also had to reduce the admission capacity of our youth training studio to a bare minimum.

As if this was not enough, our street kids' welfare program was hanging on a thread since we really could only reach out to street children in controlled numbers. The harsh economy that would soon unfold meant that people were struggling financially, and so fewer donors had the ability to donate. From the annual statistics in that dreadful year, private companies and big retailers were pushed to the limit – well, it was twice as hard for nonprofits.

Nonetheless, we braced ourselves for the new times and made unpleasant decisions that would help us to push on. In a nutshell, we decided that in the year 2021, we were going to reduce all our programs to sustainable level.

THIS WAS DIFFICULT, BUT IT WAS THE ONLY WAY WE WOULD ENSURE THAT SAVE A LIFE COMMUNITY REMAINED OPERATIONAL FOR THE PEOPLE WHO NEED US MOST.

Our volunteer staff adhered to all COVID-19 guidelines; wearing masks and protective equipment while on field, maintaining social distance, and mostly working from home. Now as we approach the end of the year 2021, we can say that it has been quite a slow but sure recovery.
